Ohio Clean Marina Rules and Regulations

Garbage, Recycling & Sewage

- Owner agrees to throw nothing, including treated or untreated effluent or sewage from heads or holding tanks in the harbor or basin
- A pump-out station is located at the fuel dock for your convenience.
- Boaters are responsible for cleaning area around boat dock or after launching
- All bottles, cans and other refuse must be placed within the proper receptacle. If all receptacles are full, refuse should not be placed anywhere on local grounds.

Pet Waste

- Pet owners are responsible for removing and properly disposing of waste.

Other Waste

- All potentially flammable material, (paint, oil rags & batteries) shall be disposed of in a manner that is approved by law.

Maintenance

- Boaters agree not to have any heavy work done to the vessel at the dock and to move the vessel to a boatyard for heavy work and repairs.

Contractor Safety & Environmental Protection Agreement

- Work must be done in compliance with all applicable laws and regulations, to provide for the protection of the environment from damage or pollution caused by any work done while on marina property.
- All hazardous chemical wastes must be removed from marina property.
- Chemical spills of any of the environment, or on any marina property, of any type must be reported to the Conneaut Port Authority immediately.
- Full cost of clean-up, removal and/or environmental damage for work done in a CPA marina is the responsibility of the outside contractor.

Fueling

- At no time are portable fuel cans permitted anywhere within the marina.

Miscellaneous

- Each vessel must have at least one fully charged, operable fire extinguisher on board.
- Fish cleaning and remains disposal is prohibited within Conneaut Port Authority property.
